#### Site Introduction

The school is located in a semi-rural environment with infrequent bus route. There is a C2C train station with direct line to Fenchurch Street/Southend City. There are no cycle paths. There are currently no cycle paths in East Tilbury and no parking spaces for the East Tilbury train station. Parent/Carers tend to park on the pavements or in the park and surrounding areas opposite the school when dropping off their children. The school is located on a very busy road, with frequent lorry movements to and from the local tip/quarries and factories. There is substantial

housing currently underway and planned, one opposite school site for 50 dwellings and another slightly along from school for 299 dwellings - these are now complete as of 2023.
